Cesarewitch Trends

- 1 14/15 had won over 16f or further (jumps or flat)**
- 2 14/15 ran in a class 3 or better race LTO**
- 3 Only 1 winner drawn in stall 24 or above**
- 4 14/15 had 3 or less runs in the past 3 months**
- 5 Only 1 winner from weight rank 23 or below**
- 6 Runners that had their last run at York, Goodwood or Haydock have a poor record (0/108)**
- 7 13/15 2-5 flat victories**
- 8 13/15 2-7 flat starts in current season**
- 9 13/15 OR 83-98**
- 10 12/15 ran over 14f or further LTO**
- 11 11/15 recorded highest or 2nd highest RPR 1 of last 2 starts**
- 12 11/15 had 25 or less flat starts**
- 13 11/15 carried 9-01 or less to victory**
- 14 11/15 top 4 finish LTO**

No great pace angle in this. **SIR FRANK MORGAN** looks the most likely to go from the front but he will have to do plenty of early work to get over from the far side. Apart from him it's a bit of a guessing game as to who is most likely to be on the front end here.

Most likely winner

BIG EASY (P Hobbs) – The 7-Y-O had a fine warm up for this in the Cesarewitch trial last month (a staying on 2nd) and that should have put him spot on for this. He runs here off the same mark as last year's renewal where he had a terrible draw and he actually ran better than his finishing position suggested then as he was heavily eased in the final furlong. The softening ground will suit him well and he is a live player in this.

Alternative(s)

TED SPREAD (S Smith) – A mark of 91 is still well within this one's range given he was once rated as high as 108 and was good enough to run a close 4th over 14f in a Longchamp G2 in his pomp. He isn't that level now but he can still do a job from his current mark, as highlighted by a battling win at Goodwood last time out off OR 89. His form after a break on the flat is solid (12), the softening ground will suit (Form on Good to Soft & Soft is 11871), he has good form going Right-Handed (17614) and Luke Morris is getting a good tune out of him (21). I think he has a better chance than his odds imply.

VILLA ROYALE (M Appleby) – It looks like the mare has been saved for this race by Mick Appleby, who has certainly managed to unlock her talents during the 6 races he has had her. She handles cut in the ground, is a stout stayer and looks a lively outside bet in this.
