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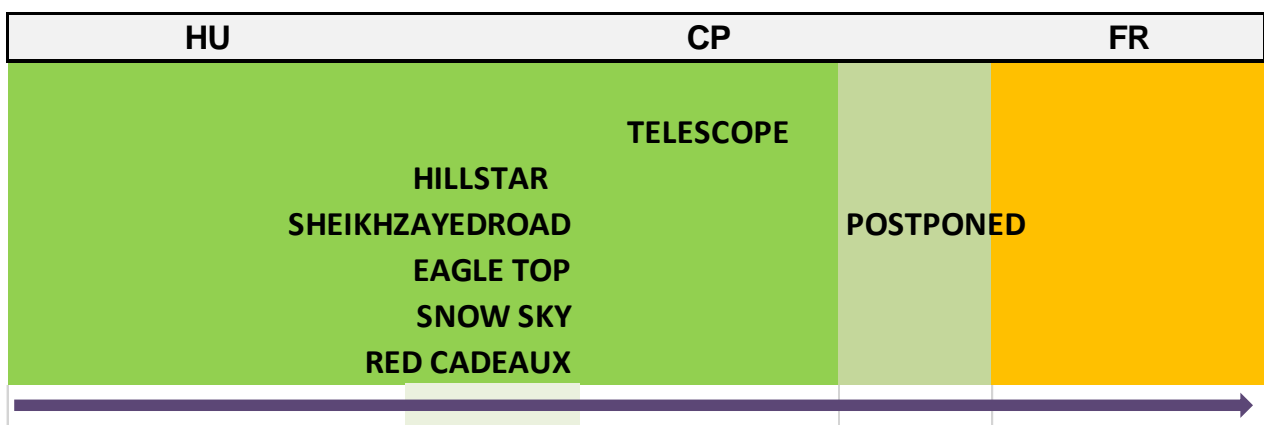

### Most likely winner

**POSTPONED (L Cumani)** – There was a lot to like about his close 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Tattersalls Gold Cup last time out, over what was probably an inadequate trip, and with this return to a longer trip sure to suit he wouldn't need to improve much at all from that effort to win this. There has always been more than a hint that he has the potential to turn into a G1 1m4f horse and this looks his chance to prove it.

### Alternative(s)

**SNOW SKY (M Stoute)** – It's a little bit of a surprise to see him at the top of the figures but he's undoubtedly a classy beast on his day and Stoute knows how to prepare one for this challenge. He could try and stretch them from half-way as they may not go all that quick here and he could well cling on for a place at lofty odds.

*Telescope – No surprise to see this one win and I couldn't put anyone off backing him, he's just a bit short for me at touching evens.*

### Most likely winner

**MUSTAJEEB (D Weld)** – This lightly raced Nayef colt made a sparkling reappearance at Curragh last month when comfortably landing a G2 and he looks ready to do the business this term over sprinting trips. He finished a fine 3<sup>rd</sup> behind Kingman last season in the Irish 2000 Guineas before following that up with victory in the Jersey Stakes at this meeting and there is every chance he can notch his second Royal Ascot victory here.

### Alternative(s)

**GLASS OFFICE (D Simcock)** – This 5yo sprung a bit of a surprise last time out at York but he could well back that up with another big run here. He had been off the track since injuring himself at Meydan in March 2014 but a warm up over 5f tuned him up perfectly for his last run and he could well improve again for that, a run that was a career best on the figures.

**ASTAIRE (K Ryan)** – The Ryan horses have been in fine form this week and after this one lost his way a little last season he seems back on the ball this term. It's easy to forget he was a G1 & G2 winner in his youth so he has the class there and Jamie Spencer gets on particularly well with him (form of 16216). He's coming back off his perfect rest period (16-30 days rest – form of 11016) and he's a lively outsider.

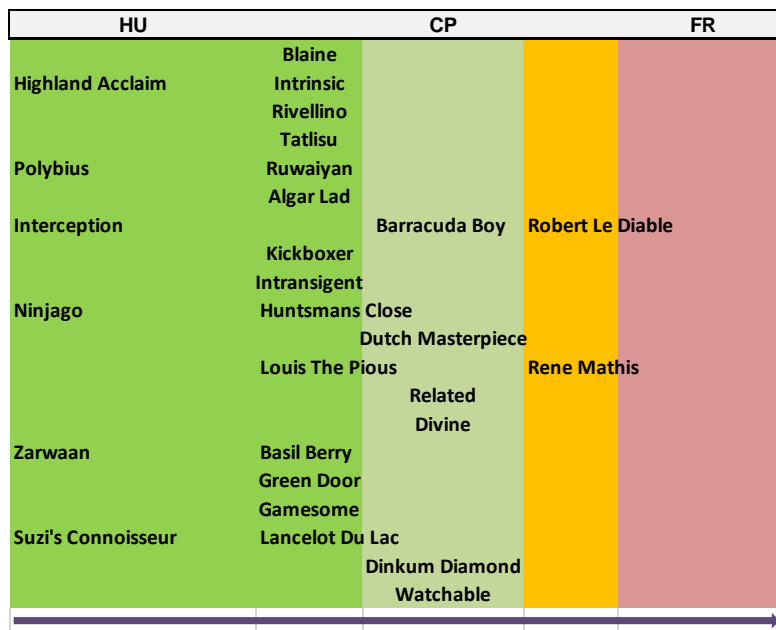

### Most likely winner

**HUNTSMANS CLOSE (R Charlton)** – Last year's Ayr Silver Cup winner looks to have an excellent of bagging another big handicap here. He made his seasonal comeback with a short-head second at Newmarket and the 4lbs he was raised for that pretty much guaranteed his place in this field, a race he seems to have been saved for after that run, the fact he is also entered in the G1 July Cup also tells us exactly how much they think of this lad. He has plenty in his favour today (ground, trip, good draw, big field - form of 01612 in 16+ fields – and Buick on-board) and looks a solid option in this.

### Alternative(s)

**TATLISU (R Fahey)** – This 4yo entered our BDH squad last term after his 8<sup>th</sup> in the Ayr Silver Cup but we never got a chance to play him. He then duly scooted in on seasonal debut at Doncaster and has kept his form on his next two starts, actually running small career bests each time. He still looks able to defy this current mark of OR 97 and with a straight 6f, running in June (46131) and Moore on his back (1334) all major bonuses I'm happy to play him here.

**INTERCEPTION (D Lanigan)** – This mare has shown improved form on her last two starts and looks a lively outsider in this. 6f is perfect for her (011112), she has form of 1113213 when returning within 30 days of her last start and loves straight tracks (023132). She will need to improve again but she has a progressive profile and improvement is far from out of the question.
